

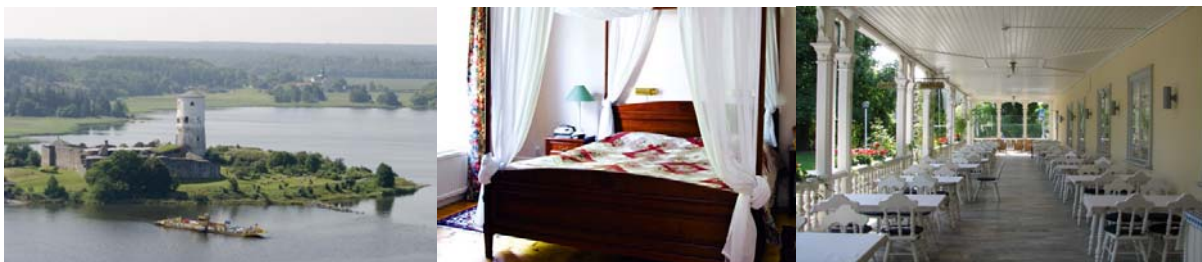


## Boattrips from Söderköping



In the medieval town Söderköping you will find a genuine Swedish atmosphere! Situated near the south eastern coastline you can experience the inner archipelago by comfortable boattours!

With destination Stegeborg and Capella Ecumenica you will take part of two floodgates before you reach the ruined castle Stegeborg and later on the famous old arcipelagochurch Capella Ecumenica. The boattrip starts at 09:30 and you will return to Söderköping in 16:30 in the evening. During the boattrip you will be served coffee and a sandwich, lunch inspired by the surrounding archipelago, coffee with tiramisu, berries and a cake.



Another boattrip have final destination Harstena, a beautiful small island in the inner archipelago. During the pleasant boattrip you will be told the history of the surroundings. Coffee with cookies and a great lunch with dessert will be served during the trip between 08:30 and 18:00. On Harstena you can enjoy the genuine atmosphere with the small red fishing houses and don't miss the unusual red water lilies!

The accommodation in Söderköping is splendid! The boattrips take part on Wednesdays and Saturdays but there will be no problem to enjoy the visit in this small town. Great restaurants, more boattrips and an extravaganza icecreamcafé want to be explored.
